Father's Day

Mother's Day gets lots of attention, but an equally important holiday comes a month later - Father's Day! This year, skip the mug and new tie and get creative with these ideas on how to encourage the dads and other influential men in your lives.

1. Put together a box of his favorite snacks and drinks. Hand him the box and the remote and give him some much needed time to relax while you take over some of his typical weekend chores.
2. Make up a scavenger hunt around your home and yard. At each stop, have an item for him to collect – snacks, gift cards, coupons.
3. Get take out from his favorite restaurant and watch any movie of his choosing.
4. Write him a list of things he has taught you and/or the things you notice that make him a great dad!
5. Put together a photo book of "Favorite Moments with Dad".
6. Engage in his hobby alongside him. *Ex: Plan a bike ride together. Play his favorite games. Get tickets to an event he'd enjoy. Go to a driving range.*
7. Go outside! Go for a hike; explore a hidden historical site; or try geocaching together.
8. Plan an adventure. Go zip lining or kayaking. Find a place where he can drive a racecar. Explore a cave. Be creative and try something new together.
9. Ask him about a local thing he's wanted to do or a place he has wanted to go, and plan that for Father's Day.
10. Ask your dad what his life was like when he was your age (or the age of your children) and "re-create" that experience with him. Go to an arcade with the video games he would have played. Or if he played a sport, go do that for a while. *Ex: Go down to the basketball court, baseball diamond, etc. Make his favorite boyhood meal for dinner.*

BONUS IDEA:

Can't be with dad on Father's Day? Have his favorite restaurant near him deliver a meal. Play trivia together over video chat while you have a meal together.
